NOTIFICATION

In continuation to Notification dated 22.03.2017 regarding inviting of applications from eligible Assistant Professors and Associate Professors of the Sansthan for considering their cases for financial upward movement/promotion under CAS of UGC, the following further clarifications as to furnishing the API criteria based PBAS proformas for the assessment period for promotion and last date of consideration period are given hereunder:-

1. Criteria for furnishing the API formats:

Illustration 1:

Eligibility of an Assistant Professor with Ph.D appointed to stage I (6000 AGP in PBIII) on 08.12.2011 became due on rendering four years of service in stage I for promotion/upward movement to the Stage II (7000 AGP in PBIII) on 08.12.2015 subject to fulfillment of other prescribed conditions. For considering his/her promotion/upward movement to the stage II (Rs.7000 AGP), he/she would require to submit duly filled in API proformas separately for concerned four years and under UGC Regulations in force during those periods as per following table:-

- **UGC Regulations 2013 (IInd amendment) came into force w.e.f. 13.06.2013**
- Eligibility of an Assistant Professor with M.Phil appointed in stage I (6000AGP in PBIII) on 08.12.2011 will become due on rendering five years of service in stage I for promotion to stage II(7000 AGP in PBIII) on 08.12.2016. In this case he/she has to submit API proforma for the period of 08.12.2015 to 10.07.2016 (as per UGC Regulations, 2013) and 11.07.2016 to 07.12.2016 (**as per UGC Regulations, 2016 (4th amendment), which came into force with effect from 11.07.2016**).

Illustration 2:

Eligibility of an Assistant Professor promoted to stage II (7000 AGP in PBIII) as on 15.08.2009 became due on rendering five years of service in stage II for promotion/upward movement to the Stage III (8000 AGP in PBIII) on 15.08.2014 subject to fulfillment of other prescribed conditions. For considering his/her promotion/upward

movement to the stage III (Rs.8000 AGP), he/she would require to submit duly filled in API proformas separately for concerned five years and under UGC Regulations in force during those periods as per following table:-

- UGC Regulations 2013 (IInd amendment) came into force w.e.f. 13.06.2013

Illustration 3:

Eligibility of an Associate Professor promoted to the Stage IV(9000AGP in PBIV) as on 10.04.2013 became due on rendering five years of service in stage IV for promotion/upward movement to the Stage V (10000 AGP in PBIV) on 10.04.2016 subject to fulfilment of other prescribed conditions. For considering his/her promotion/upward movement to the stage V (Rs.10000 AGP), he/she would require to submit duly filled in API proformas separately for concerned three years and under UGC Regulations in force during those periods as per following table:-

2. Last date of consideration for promotion/upward movement under CAS of UGC has been fixed as 30.04.2017.
3. It is also clarified that those cases which have matured upto 30.04.2017 will only be taken into consideration for evaluation at present. There may also be cases where promotions are due for two stages within the prescribed date of consideration, ie. 30.04.2017. But during their present process, the cases for first due promotion only will be considered.
4. The last date for receipt of applications along with duly completed API proformas and other documents in the Headquarter Office of the Sansthan is extended upto **31.05.2017**. However, the prescribed last date of consideration period will remain the same, i.e. **30.04.2017**.
5. API proformas as per UGC Regulations-2010, 2013 and 2016 have been uploaded on Sansthan's Website: www.sanskrit.nic.in . API proforma pertaining to the concerned period is required to be submitted.
6. For further details, relevant UGC Regulations may be referred.
